Feeling Squirrelly!

The next time you're spending time outside, riding in a car, or sitting at home near a window, look around. Do you see any squirrels? These little critters are some of the most common wildlife in North America, and they're a lot of fun to watch!

Squirrels are mammals, and are easily recognized by their big, bushy tails and large eyes. Most squirrels you see scampering around are tree squirrels and usually have brown or gray fur. Their long hind feet allow them to climb trees with ease, while their tail helps them stay balanced. If you've ever watched a squirrel run along a tree branch or the top of a fence, you've seen their trapeze act in action!

Nuts, seeds and fruit are among a squirrel's favorite things to eat. They are famous for gathering food for the winter by burying various goodies to find later. Squirrels are so smart that they can find most of the spots they've hidden their food by using their memory and sharp sense of smell. They will also trick other animals by pretending to bury something, then scurrying off. Any animals watching may then dig in the same spot to steal the squirrel's snack, only to find nothing! Meanwhile, the squirrel has hidden their real food in a different place.

Tree squirrels will also store food in their nests, called dreys, which they build out of twigs and leaves high up in tall trees. A squirrel's nest is bigger than a bird's nest and looks like a large pile of leaves. Find a large tree and try to spot a drey in the branches. Squirrels will also shelter in holes created by woodpeckers. These dens keep the squirrels safe, warm and dry during cold weather.
